What is a chimney crown?

A chimney crown is a masonry roof that covers the top of your chimney. It prevents water from seeping into the masonry below. Water damaged or cracked chimney crowns can lead to costly chimney repairs.

The crown solution.

Cold Weather CrownCoat is a flexible waterproof sealant that is applied over the entire chimney crown. A professionally installed Cold Weather CrownCoat application stops further water intrusion through the crown and carries a 10 year warranty.



Visible Signs Of Damage Include...

- Cracking of the crown
- Cracking of the brick
- Spalling (flaking) of brick
- Deteriorating mortar joints
- Efflorescence (white stains)

When water penetrates through cracks in your crown and freezes, it expands, deteriorating your chimney's crown and the masonry below it. Preventing water damage to your chimney will save you thousands in expensive repairs.

Putting off this repair until warmer weather means further damage to your chimney. Cold Weather CrownCoat is a tough elastomeric coating that will cure in temperatures below freezing. This allows you to stop further water damage "cold", even in the winter months.
